



Contest Rules:

- Registration is now open. Entries must be submitted in person by the entrant on Saturday, 11/9/24, from
- 8:30AMto9:30AM at the Pierce County Chamber of Commerce, 200SW Central Ave., Blackshear, GA
- Entry Fee: Early Registration \$10 fee for first entry; \$5 for each additional entry (\$15 and \$10 if entering the day of the event.)
- Participants may enter up to three entries.
- Entries must be entered in the name of the person who made the dish.
- Contestants must indicate on the registration form if the entry is to be sold and the proceeds donated to the Exchange Club's charities, or if the entry is to be returned to the contestant after judging. If contestants choose to have entries sold, the entered pies/desserts and the containers become the property of the festival committee, and pie plates/pans will not be returned.
- Optional: 2 pies (desserts) may be submitted (one to judge and keep, one to sell for charitable donation).
- A complete recipe is not required, but each entry must include a list of ingredients.
- Contestants agree that photos and contact information may be taken and used for marketing purposes.

Prizes:

- *Clough's Traditional Pecan Pie Grand Champion* (\$50) & 1st Place Ribbon; *Traditional Pecan Pie Runner-Up* (\$25) & 2nd Place Ribbon
- Clough's Pecan Dessert Grand Champion (\$50) & 1st Place Ribbon; Pecan Dessert Runner-Up (\$25) & 2nd

Judging:

Judging will begin around 10:00 AM. Results will be announced from the main stage in the city park that afternoon. Judges' decisions are final, and they are not required to provide feedback about their decisions. Entries will be scored on the following criteria (25 possible points):

- Overall Appearance/Presentation Up to 5 Points
- Flavor (aroma, taste, balance of flavoring) Up to 5 Points
- Texture/Consistency (evenly baked, doneness) Up to 5 Points
- Moistness/Crumb (as applicable to category) Up to 5 Points
- Creativity/Originality Up to 5 Points

#4 Exhibitor must provide his/her own means of display/tent and remain with their products the entire length of the festival.

#5 All display material should be contained inside the space allotted for them.

#6 Please provide a detailed list of the food/arts/crafts, and any other items you will be providing. Feel free to write on the form, if needed.

#7 All entry fees must be paid in full and turned in with the completed application. At this time, mail is our only option. **DEADLINE Oct 4th**.

#8 No refunds will be given due to interruption in the festival, as a result of weather, or any cause beyond the control of the Exchange Club of Blackshear.

#9 All applicants will receive a confirmation of receipt by phone, email or text, once their application and fee is received and processed.

#10 Collecting and paying 7% sales tax is the responsibility of the vendor.
